Why are so many envelopes included in our monthly packets?

The purpose of offertory envelopes is to give you a contribution report at the end of the year for tax purposes. In addition the extra envelopes give you the opportunity to contribute to funds which are important for you.

Many parishioners wish to contribute to special funds...for example, maintenance or heating of the church as well as missionary efforts such as the Guatemala missions. These special envelopes make it easier for parishioners to make that gift.

Of course envelopes are completely voluntary. If you do not use envelopes you receive because you contribute weekly or monthly by personal checks or checks directly sent by your bank you can call our parish office and ask to have envelopes discontinued.

In addition we have "generic" envelopes in the pews for visitors who wish to contribute and for parishioners who forget their envelopes.

The envelope service is precisely that...a service to make it easier for our parishioners to contribute in ways that meet their needs and contribute to the works of the Church.
