Communion Rite Posture

I have decided to ask the faithful to kneel after the "Lamb of God" so as to be in harmony with most of the other dioceses in the United States. I believe this posture of kneeling while the priest shows the Sacred Species to the people is more appropriate. The translation of the Roman Missal, third typical edition, uses the word "behold" the Lamb of God instead of "this is" the Lamb of God. The word "behold" is a more accurate imperative which reflects the transcendent mystery before us—a mystery that should indeed drive us to our knees in love and adoration. Bishop Daly
